VINEYARD DESCRIPTION

The Sobreira de Baixo vineyard was planted in 2008, situated at an average altitude of 280 meters and is rain-fed. The grapevines are trained using the bilateral cordon system and have a northwest to southwest orientation.

SOIL

Granitic origin with a high clay content, sandy texture with balanced fertility. Presence of quartz.

CLIMATIC YEAR

The 2020-2021 season recorded a total of 721 mm of precipitation, which ensured that water was not a limiting factor in the vegetative cycle. The mild and dry spring and summer reduced the incidence of diseases and extended the growing season. White wines are showing freshness and balance, with a remarkable aromatic exuberance, suggesting that this could be one of the best years for white wines.

VINIFICATION

The grapes were hand-harvested in 25kg boxes and transported immediately to the winery, where they were stored in a cold room for 24 hours. This was followed by grape selection, pneumatic pressing, and decantation. Alcoholic fermentation began in stainless steel tanks with selected yeast. 70% of the must was transferred to 500-liter barrels, and the wine was kept in contact with the fine lees with periodic batonnage.

AGING

12 months in Austrian Oak Foudre of 20hL. 12 months in the bottle.

TASTING NOTE

Expressive citrus notes, with a focus on grapefruit, and a very fine barrel note. In the mouth, it maintains a citrus profile with creaminess, body, and vigor.
